Dear Speaker Pelosi,

I am writing to you today on behalf of the 209,281 members of the Council of Seniors.

The Council of Seniors is a national non-partisan, non-profit organization that works to educate, inform and advocate on behalf of our members regarding issues concerning the uncertain future of Social Security.

A major concern for our members is the issue of Totalization. Specifically, the Council of Seniors and our members are concerned with, and opposed to, the proposed Totalization agreement with Mexico.

In the last twelve months we have contacted nearly four million citizens from across the country regarding the future of Social Security and the effects of entering into a Totalization agreement with Mexico will have on Social Security.

And results from a national survey conducted by the Council of Seniors reveal that 93% of respondents are opposed to the United States entering into a Totalization agreement with Mexico.

We have also learned from our survey that 79% of respondents are opposed to granting any form of amnesty to illegal aliens.

Respondents to our national survey also indicated that they are overwhelmingly (77%) in support of repealing the 1993 tax increase on Social Security.


